Dear Parent/Guardian of aLIVE Students

Temporary Suspension of aLIVE Face-to-Face Classes at Mosques

May you and your family be in the best of health.

2 Earlier this year, mosque madrasah commenced the gradual resumption of face-to-face aLIVE classes for Academic Year 2021. During weeks when students are not scheduled to attend face-to-face classes, the aLIVE Home-Based Learning package will be used. We deeply appreciate your support and partnership with asatizah over the past few months to ensure that Islamic learning continues for our children during this challenging period.

3 However, due to the current increase in COVID-19 cases in the community, the Multi-Ministry Taskforce on COVID-19 has issued new guidelines on activities conducted at places of worship, including our mosques. Following these new guidelines, all aLIVE classes at mosques will be moved online with effect from 8 May 2021. Asatizah will continue guiding students to learn Islam from home. The mosque madrasah will update parents/guardians of aLIVE students on the details of Home-Based Learning (HBL) Package and online class schedule matters.

4 During the week of HBL, the mosque madrasah will provide instructions and support for your child/ward to access the online resources so that Islamic learning can continue from home. Asatizah will continue to monitor the progress of your child through the HBL quizzes and follow-up with them online.

5 Our Asatizah have been actively upskilling themselves in the area of online teaching and refining their skills in this new area. We thank you for your support, encouragement and cooperation given to asatizah as they embark in this new mode of teaching and learning experience.

6 Muis will continue to monitor the COVID-19 situation closely and provide the necessary support to our mosque madrasah, Asatizah and students. Parents are strongly encouraged to keep your children at home during this period.

7 We will review the aLIVE learning arrangements should there be changes to the guidelines on activities at mosques for Term 3 and update parents/guardians accordingly.

1. Temporary Suspension of aLIVE F2F Classes

In lieu of the temporary suspension of aLIVE face-to-face (F2F) classes in mosques, all aLIVE classes at Masjid Maarof will shift to Home-Based Learning (aHBL) from Lesson 6 of Term 2, 7 May 2021 onwards.

We will notify parents of the class format for Term 3 prior to the commencement, insyaAllah; subject to developments of national advisories.

2. aLIVE Home-Based Learning (aHBL)

As a reminder, the aLIVE Home-Based Learning (aHBL) comprises of the following:

- i. **Video conference session** with respective class asatizah via Zoom. This virtual meet-up with asatizah is now extended by half an hour. For weekend classes, there are no changes to the Zoom links and passcodes. For Friday classes previously on full F2F format, the Zoom details will be shared via email and sms, insyaAllah.

Submissions can be in the form of email text, or attachment of documents, photos and audio files.

3. Hari Raya and June Holiday Closure

Madrasah will be closed 14 – 16 May 2021 during the Hari Raya Aidilfitri weekend. Classes will resume 18 May 2021 onwards, including night classes.

The last day of Term 2 for Friday afternoon and weekend sessions is 30 May 2021. For night classes, the last day will be on 18 June 2021. Term 3 will resume 29 June 2021. You may refer to the Term 2 schedule for further details.

4. Assessment for Quran Recitation Class (QRC)

Semester 1 Assessment for QRC weekend sessions will be held on 22-23 May 2021. Asatizah will be conducting revision this weekend to prepare students.

5. Infaq Ramadan

During these final days of Ramadan, we welcome your contributions to Masjid Maarof's Ramadan Fund. Proceeds are channelled towards the Ramadan mosque operations, religious programmes, and porridge distribution efforts. Excess funds will be utilised for general mosque operations.
